ABOUT THE STUDIES AND THE DIPLOMA

The program adapted from the Directive 2005/36/EC and aligned with the Bologna structure.

Comprised of 360 ECTS (credits)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Documents written in English, French, Spanish, or Slovenian are acceptable, there is no need for a translation to Croatian.

- a proof of payment of the Application Fee (excluding bank processing charge/costs)

- original or certified copies of Secondary School Certificates and the Final/Leaving Secondary School Certificate of education. Applicants <u>who</u> <u>are in their last year of secondary school</u> <u>studies</u> at the time of the application deadline may also apply, but will be obliged to produce their qualification certificates before registration
- certificates of higher courses or degrees (college/ university), if applicable
- proof of knowledge of English language (TOEFL, IELTS, CAE or other proofs or certificates)
- certificate(s) proving their "hands-on" experience by working with veterinarians in the veterinary field, if any
- medical certificate confirming general good health and physical ability to study Veterinary Medicine
