1. Take immediate action to secure the place affected by the fire	2. Provide assistance to injured persons - organize care for injured persons	3. Head informs person responsible for coordination (Safety at Work, Fire protection, Environment)

2. EARTHQUAKE OR DAMAGE TO INSTALLATIONS

1. Take immediate action to secure damaged place	2. Provide assistance to injured persons - organize care for injured persons	3. Remove important equipment from damaged place DO NOT THREATEN YOUR SAFETY	4. Inform immediately Head of the department / clinic	5. Head informs person responsible for coordination (Safety at Work, Fire protection, Environment)

2. SPILL OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES INTO THE ENVIRONMENT (acids, base, oils; toxic, infectious, radioactive waste)

1. At the site of the spill IMMEDIATELY throw agent for absorption over dangerous substances	2. Wait for the absorption of the dangerous substance	3. Carefully pick up the waste and dispose it in provided place	3. In case of spills of larger quantities of dangerous substances, immediately inform Head of Dpt	5. Head informs persons responsible for coordination
