Dear Deer Friends!

We cordially invite you to the 10th International Deer Biology Congress (IDBC) that will be held from September 4-9, 2022, at the Faculty of Agrobiotechnical Sciences, Osijek, Croatia.

Our main is to gather professionals interested in deer biology, disease, conservation and management in wild and farmed conditions. IDBC offers possibilities to discuss common problems, share knowledge or experiences whilst reviving old and creating new networks. Some of the major topics will include; general deer biology and ecology, diseases, evolution, genetics, management, in-situ and ex-situ conservation, antler biology, and antler and venison production. The COVID-19 pandemic has caused many restrictions, resulting in an online type of function. Let's hope that 10th IDBC will be held in normal person-to-person conditions, allowing direct exchange of knowledge and creation of new relationships, in order to spark new endeavours in cervid research, conservation, management and production.

History

An initial conference on "Antler Development in Cervidae" was organized in 1982 in Kingsville (Texas) by Robert Brown. This event started the tradition of the subsequent International Deer Biology Congress series. A year later, the First International Deer Biology Congress was held in Dunedin (New Zealand) in 1983. After the First Congress, it took 7 years until Robert Brown organized the second one in Mississippi (USA), in 1990. This Congress marked the further establishment of Congress, held every quadrennial. The third Congress was held in Edinburgh (UK) in 1994, 4th in Kaposvar (Hungary) in 1998, 5th in Quebec (Canada) in 2002, 6th in Prague (Czech Republic) in 2006, 7th in Huilo Huilo (Chile) in 2010, 8th in Harbin (China) in 2014 and 9th in Colorado (USA) in 2018. Each conference covered a wide range of topics including deer biology, ecology, antler biology, conservation, evolution, genetics and deer health.

The International Deer Biology Congress aims to gather a wide array of scientists who are working with any deer species. This also includes biologists, foresters, agriculturalists, veterinarians and conservationists. We also aim to include deer farmers, hunting managers, National and Nature Park representatives and all other professions who are directly involved in deer management and ecology.

Submission of abstracts

Abstracts can be submitted only online via https://www.deerbiologycongress.org/. It is necessary that each author mark whether presentation will be ORAL or POSTER. Authors will be notified by the Scientific Steering Committee by paper acceptance. All abstracts will be published in Congress Book of Abstracts for Congress purposes and finally in the Animal Production Science Journal (https://www.publish.csiro.au/an). Invited speakers are required to submit a full-length paper. Potentially, authors of selected abstracts may be invited to submit a full paper.

Guidelines for authors Abstract

Abstracts should be no more than 350 words. Abstract should state precisely why the study was done, what hypothesis was tested, and how the study was undertaken; should also give the principal findings and conclusions; and should highlight the implications for livestock and food production. Abstracts of research articles should be formatted to include the following labelled sections: Context, Aims, Methods, Key results, Conclusions, Implications, Abstracts of Reviews. Perspective and Viewpoint articles do not need to be formatted with sections but should still provide a concise overview of the full manuscript. A minimum of 8 key words or phrases are required to improve online discoverability of your work. These terms can be repeated from the title if necessary. List the keywords under the abstract, with terms separated by commas.

Poster session

Posters should be of maximum size 120 x 80 cm. The poster should be legible from a distance of 2 m. Equipment necessary for mounting of posters will be available on-site.





George A. Bubenik Memorial Award

In memory of G. A. Bubenik, the organizers will award one presenter (younger than 35 yrs) with a memorial plaque, a monetary award of 200 EUR and a Book by organizer's choice. The criteria for selection are: 1) The originality of the research idea and the degree of innovation in the techniques used, 2) The excellence in evaluation of data obtained, 3) The clarity of presentation, and 4) The knowledgeable discussion of the results with the public. The winner will be selected by the panel of international scientists named at the meeting.

The candidates for the award should indicate on their abstract that they want to be considered for the competition.

Conference excursion

Kopački rit

Kopački rit is a natural triangle between Danube and Drava Rivers, a floodplain that offers home and refuge for more than 2300 animal species on 231 km². As one of the largest European swamps, Kopački rit is never the same and its shape is heavily influenced by amount and intensity of water carried by the Danube River. This Nature Park is listed as important bird area (IBA), protected by Ramsar convention and UNESCO.

MAIN EXCURSION - KOPAČKI RIT NATURE PARK - BARANJA

Departure from Osijek, at the arranged location at 9.00 a.m. Short drive to **KOPAČKI RIT Nature Park**, one of the largest wetland areas in Europe. Located at the confluence of the Rivers Drava and Danube, this intra-continental delta is home to more than 290 species of birds, such as white-tailed eagles, white and black storks, herons, cormorants, swans and wild ducks. The park is also home to tens of species of other animals, such as deer, wild boar, badgers, beavers, foxes and pine martens, and various kinds of lizards and snakes, of which none in the park is poisonous. Embarking on the Tourist Boat followed by a tour of the Nature Park. After the tour, a drive around Baranja. Tour and wine tasting at the Belje wine cellars, with the "Baranja, the Mother of Wine" package (includes: professionally guided wine tasting, three top quality wines, professional guide for tour of Belje wine cellars, palate cleansers). Tour of the Wine Route. We suggest lunch at the Josić Restaurant and Winery (supplementary cost). Return to Osijek in the early afternoon.

OPTION I - THE CASTLES OF SLAVONIA

Departure from Osijek by tourist coach, from the agreed location at 9.00 a.m. Drive to DAKOVO. Upon arrival, tour of the Stud Farm, with a professional guide. Tour of places of interest: St. Peter's Cathedral, the Archbishop's palace, the late-Baroque canonical residence, the Secession building of the Catholic Seminary, Strossmayer Park, and the pedestrian street (Korzo). Drive to NAŠICE. Visit to Pejačević Castle. Tour of the exterior of the castle (a tour of the interior is not possible as work is in progress inside). Pejačević Castle is located in the centre of Našice. It stands in a park, now the city park, together with a smaller castle, farm buildings and recently built apartment blocks and a hotel. It is named after the famous noble Pejačević family. Drive to DONJI MIHOLJAC. Tour of Prandau-Mailath Castle. One of the first major buildings in Donji Miholjac, it was built in 1818 for the noble Prandau family. The building is in the late-Baroque style, and it was the first to be entirely covered with tiles. It has two salons, fourteen rooms, and several kitchens and larders. Today the castle is the seat of the Donji Miholjac town council. After the tour, we continue driving towards VALPOVO. Upon arrival, a tour of the town and a visit to Prandau-Norman Castle. This medieval-Baroque castle complex in Valpovo is one of the oldest and largest castles in Slavonia, and is one of the most valuable historical, architectural complexes of secular architecture in northern Croatia. After all these tours, we suggest a drive to the Eden-Emaus resort, a unique natural resort in Slavonia and Baranja, where the beauty of the unspoiled oak forest, the naturally clean lakes and endless meadows is combined with the rich and unique menu. Lunch is charged extra. Return to Osijek in the early afternoon.

OPTION II - ILOK

Departure from Osijek, at the arranged location, at 9.00 a.m. Drive in tourist coach to the easternmost town of our Beautiful Homeland - ILOK. Tour of the town: the Church and Monastery of St. John Capitstran, the Castle of the Odescalchi family from the outside, the walls... Visit to the Stari podrumi wine cellars dating from the 15th and 18th centuries, which hold part of the total wine production and valuable archive collections of Traminac, Graševina (Welschriesling), Rhein Riesling, and White Pinot, and continue the millennia old tradition of grape growing on the rolling plateau on the western sides of Fruška Gora, falling down to the mighty Danube. We suggest lunch in the Stari podrumi restaurant or the Danube Hotel in Ilok, standing right on the Danube, with a beautiful view over the river (for an additional payment). A ride in the Traminac Express tourist train to the country estate of Principovac, from whose viewing platform there is an astounding view over Ilok, Srijem and Bačka. Return to Osijek by coach in the afternoon.


Accommodation
